There is **NO kneeling** or **fasting** from 25 December through 4 January. Thursday, 5 January is a day of strict fast in preparation for the great feast of the Theophany of our Lord, God and Savior Jesus Christ. Although the Theophany falls on a Friday in 2012, there is **NO fasting** or **abstinence** on Friday.

Jordan Water will be consecrated Thursday evening after the *Ambon Prayer*. Since Compline will not be celebrated, bread will be blessed after the consecration of water. Traditionally, water is blessed twice on Theophany. The first blessing after the Vigil Divine Liturgy, or Vespers, is the Jordan Water that will be kept in the church. The second blessing, after the Divine Liturgy on the day of the feast, is of a local river, or nearby body of water.

The final day, the leave-taking of Theophany, the Otdanije in Slavonic, is Saturday, 14 January. THEOPHANY IS A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION FOR ALL BYZANTINE CATHOLICS!!!
