DID YOU KNOW? A priest or deacon is **FORBIDDEN** to omit elements from the Liturgy on his own authority, simply to «get'em in; get'em out». To dispense with the Propers of the day [Troparion, Kontakion, Prokeimenon, Alleluia, etc.] or the homily or to cut out portions of the Anaphora to make it shorter «renders the celebration of the Sacred Liturgy unstable, and not infrequently distorts the authentic meaning of the Liturgy*. A priest must always remember that he is a servant of the Sacred Liturgy.†» and not its manipulator.
