~ PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS ~

O Holy Virgin, Theotokos, with confidence you told those at the wedding feast of Cana, «Do whatever my Son tells you.» Ask Him to provide an abundance of vocations for His holy Byzantine Catholic Church. Amen.

The Holy Great Prince Vladimir of Kiev ~ Equal to the Apostles: Grandson of Saint Olga, Saint Vladimir ascended the throne of Kiev in 980. Though a zealous idolater, he was illumined by the grace of God, accepted the Christian Faith, and completely changed his ways. He was baptized in Cherson in 988, receiving the name Basil; he came forth from the font not only healed of a blindness lately afflicting him, but also from being passionate and warlike,



he became meek, peaceable, and exceedingly godly. Whereas his grandmother had refused marriage with the Emperor in Constantinople (see July 11), he married Anna, sister of the Emperors Basil and Constantine, and was accompanied home by priests from Constantinople. Diligently seeking to spread Christianity throughout his realm like a new Constantine, he destroyed the idols (having the chief deity Perun scourged and then cast into the Dnieper River), and summoned all his subjects to Holy Baptism. He reposed in peace in 1015.

Apolytikion in the Fourth Tone: You were like a merchant who seeks a goodly pearl, O glorious Sovereign Vladimir, sitting on the height of the throne of the mother of cities, God-protected Kiev. Searching and sending to the imperial city to know the Orthodox Faith, you did find Christ, the priceless Pearl, Who chose you as a second Paul, and Who did shake off your spiritual and bodily blindness in the holy font. Wherefore, we who are your people celebrate your falling asleep. Pray that all Orthodox people be granted peace and great mercy.

Kontakion in the Plagal of the Fourth Tone: Like the great Apostle Paul, O most glorious Vladimir, in your maturity you did forsake all zeal for idols and a childish sophism, and as a full-grown man you were adorned with the royal purple of divine Baptism. And now as you stand in joy in the presence of Christ our Saviour, pray that all Orthodox people be granted peace and great mercy.
