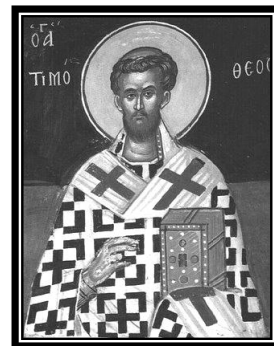
**The Peter and Paul (Apostles) Fast**

The Apostles Fast began, 3 June, after Vespers and lasts until June 28. The Typikon prescribes strict abstinence on **Mondays, Wednesdays,** and **Fridays,** with a mitigated abstinence (Wine and Oil) on Tuesday and Thursday. The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a penitential season (Canon 880, §2). This fast may be observed voluntarily.

Being one of the four fasting periods of the Church, this is also a proper and salutary time for receiving our Lord's loving forgiveness in the Mystery of Holy Confession.



The **Hieromartyr Timothy, Bishop of Prusa** in Bithynia (northern modern-day Turkey) received from the Lord the gift of wonderworking because of his purity and sanctity of life. At Prusa he converted many pagans to the faith in Christ. The emperor Julian the Apostate (361-363), upon hearing about St Timothy had him locked up in prison, but even there also the saint continued to preach the Gospel. Julian forbade him to teach about Jesus Christ, but the saint continued to spread the Christian Faith. Finally, the emperor gave orders to behead the saint. His holy relics were afterwards transferred to Constantinople.
