~ The Peter and Paul (Apostles) Fast ~

The Apostles Fast began, 3 June, after Vespers and lasts until June 28. The Typikon prescribes strict abstinence on **Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays**, with a mitigated abstinence (Wine and Oil) on Tuesday and Thursday. The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a penitential season (Canon 880, §2). This fast may be observed voluntarily.

Being one of the four fasting periods of the Church, this is also a proper and salutary time for receiving our Lord's loving forgiveness in the Mystery of Holy Confession.
