## Sixth Week of the Great Fast:

During this week, we go from the Canon of Lazarus, the poor man abused by the rich, and follow Christ on his way to Bethany to give life to Lazarus, his friend, the promise of resurrection to all. On Friday we conclude the Fast of Forty Days and begin the Fast of Holy Week. At Vespers, we read the story of Joseph and his brothers. Joseph is a type of Jesus the Messiah, who died and is risen.

**Kontakion, Tone 8:** Jacob lamented before the coat, as the brothers revealed their cruelty. Making a slave of Joseph, they sold him to the impious, but he placed all his hope in God, and from him received a royal crown, as he proclaimed, "The Lord alone is great. He is our Savior."

As we enter the sixth week of this holy Fast, let us sing a hymn in preparation for the feast of Palms to Christ Who comes for our sake seated upon the colt of a donkey. He comes forth as a king to subject the nations to His Father. Let us prepare the branches of our virtues so that, in joy, we may see His glorious Resurrection.

On November 14, 1996, the National Conference of Catholic Bishops approved the following guidelines on the reception of communion. The guidelines seek to remind all those who are attending Catholic liturgies of the present discipline of the Church with regard to the sharing of Eucharistic communion. [The following applies to Catholics of all rites, eastern and western.]

As Catholics, we fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when we receive Holy Communion. We are encouraged to receive Communion devoutly and frequently. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, participants should not be conscious of grave sin and normally should have fasted for one hour. A person who is conscious of grave sin is not to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without prior sacramental confession except for a grave reason where there is no opportunity for confession. In this case, the person is to be mindful of the obligation to make an act of perfect contrition, including the intention of confessing as soon as possible (canon 916). A frequent reception of the Sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.
