DID YOU KNOW? Mnohaya Lita (Ukrainian: Многая літа literally "Many Summers!" but with the implied meaning "I (we) wish you many years of life") is a traditional Ukrainian song that is sung at various times of celebration. The song is based on the Greek: Εις πολλά έτη, Eis polla etē, meaning "Many Years to You" and is based on the Byzantine Christian polychronion or the hierarchal acclimation Tov Δεσπότην, Ton Despotin, which is normally sung at the end of church services to the bishop, metropolitan, or patriarch who has presided at the Divine Liturgy. The song is

also sung both at informal gatherings (such as birthdays or name days) or at formal events, such as weddings, church events, et cetera.

Suffrages: short intercessory prayer or petitions offered for the living and the dead.

[Latin: **suffragium**, -i (n.) < **suffragari**: to be favorable, to favor, recommend, support] The Feast of Mid-Pentecost: The giving of the Spirit unites the beginning and the

end of the fifty day feast of our Lord. On Pascha, the Lord, the Giver of Life, breathed the Holy Spirit upon His apostles for the forgiveness of sins, and on Pentecost, the Lord sent the Holy Spirit upon His followers that the Gospel for the baptism of repentance might be preached to all nations. Through the Holy Spirit, we are united with Christ in Holy Communion and are deified by His power. In the middle of the feast we celebrate all these wondrous works of God. The feast has a Postfestive period that concludes on the following Wednesday.



On Mid-Pentecost we hear the call of the Lord: "Whosoever thirsts, let him come to Me and drink" (John 7:37). If this is so, then let us all run to Him. Whatever you thirst for - so long as it is not contrary to the spirit of the Lord - you will find relief in Him. If you thirst for knowledge, run to the Lord, for He is the one and only light, enlightening every man. If you thirst for cleansing from sin and quenching of the flames of your conscience, run to the Lord, for He tore asunder the handwriting of our sins upon the Cross. If you thirst for peace in your heart, run to the Lord, for He is the treasury of all good, Whose abundance will teach you to forget all deprivations and despise all earthly goods, so as to be filled with Him alone. If you need strength, He is almighty. If you need glory, His glory surpasses the world. If you desire freedom, He gives true freedom. He will resolve all of our doubts, loose the bonds of our passions, dispel all our troubles and difficulties, will enable us to overcome all obstacles, temptations and intrigues of the enemy, and will make smooth the path of our spiritual life.
