**Week of the Man Born Blind:** Jesus anointed the eyes of the Man Born Blind, and he was enlightened, professing Jesus to be his Lord. He is an image of our baptism, when we are illuminated out of darkness by the anointing of the chrism of the Holy Spirit. We remember the salvation of the Man Born Blind and our own baptism as we come to the close of the Feast of the glorious Resurrection of our Lord and God and Savior Jesus Christ.

**Kontakion, Tone 5:** With eyes that are spiritually blind I come to you, O Christ; and like the man who was blind since birth, I cry out to you with repentance: You are a shining light to those who are in darkness.

**Ekos 12** You, the effulgence of the Father did go unto the Mount of Olives and then a most bright cloud did lift You up, as Your disciples looked on, O Almighty One, and Your angels said unto Your Apostles, 'Men of Galilee, why stand you gazing up into Heaven? Him Whom you see taken up from you shall come again in the flesh. And they returned to Jerusalem with joy, praising You, the true God, and offering praises unto Your life-bearing tomb, wherein You were laid and on the third day did rise:



Rejoice, life-bearing tomb, for from you Christ, the ineffable light, shone forth and enlightened the whole world!

Rejoice, for the Myrrhbearers did hear, Rejoice! when Christ arose from you!

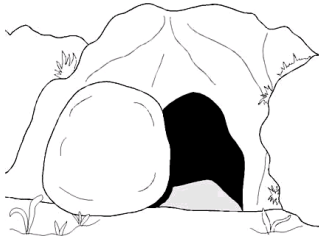
Rejoice, for you have been the resting-place of the King of kings and Lord of lords!
