v. Praise Him, all His angels; praise Him, all His hosts.

The Typical Psalms are portions of **Psalms 102** and **145** coupled w/ the **Beatitudes** of Matthew's Gospel, which may replace, under certain circumstances, the three Sunday Antiphons at the Divine Liturgy. Psalm 102 replaces the 1st Sunday Antiphon; Psalm 145, the 2nd Sunday Antiphon; and the Beatitudes are sung in place of the 3rd Sunday Antiphon. In the Slave tradition, which includes the Ruthenian Byzantine Churches, these may be used during the fasting periods throughout the year and / or on week days. Beginning next Sunday, 15 November – the start of the Nativity Fast – we will sing the Typical Psalms and the Beatitudes at the Divine Liturgy. Over the past few weeks, in order to familiarize you with the tones, the choir has been singing them before the start of the Liturgy.
