

TYPHOON HAIYAN: Archbishop William received notice from the USCCB – the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops – that all Catholic parishes in the USA are being asked to take up a special collection as soon as possible for the people in the Philippines and Vietnam who are suffering greatly from the effects of typhoon Haiyan.

These funds will be used to support the efforts of the Catholic Relief Services in response to immediate emergency needs for such necessities as water, food, shelter and medical care and to assist in the long-term recovery from the disaster. Collection funds will also be used to support the long-term need to rebuild the Church in these countries after such widespread destruction.

Please use one of the "special" envelopes in your offertory box for this important collection and **clearly mark on the front of the envelope: TYPHOON HAIYAN**. The parish will then send one check for the total amount collected to the Archeparchial offices in Pittsburgh who will then forward monies to Catholic Relief Services.

As we prepare to celebrate Thanksgiving Day both as a parish and as a nation, let us be especially mindful of the abundant blessings that we have and let us also call to mind the words of our blessed Savior:

«...for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.' Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see Thee hungry and feed Thee, or thirsty and give Thee drink? And when did we see Thee a stranger and welcome Thee, or naked and clothe Thee? And when did we see Thee sick or in prison and visit Thee?' And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to Me.'»

- ... IS ACTIVE IN THE SOCIAL MINISTRY OF THE PARISH.
- ... supports the Church monetarily according to his or her means.
- ... if married, celebrated a valid Catholic marriage.
