


The Lord's Day – The Day of the Resurrection: the new creation - Jesus rose from the dead "on the first day of the week." Because it is the "first day," the day of Christ's Resurrection recalls the first creation. Because it is the "8th day" following the Sabbath, it symbolizes the new creation ushered in by Christ's Resurrection. For Christians it has become the first of all days, the first of all feasts, the Lord's Day – Sunday: *We all gather on the day of the sun, for it is the first day [after the Jewish Sabbath, but also the first day when God, separating matter from darkness, made the world; and on this same day Jesus Christ our Savior rose from the dead (St Justin the Martyr).*

Sunday - Fulfillment of the Sabbath Sunday is expressly distinguished from the Sabbath which it follows chronologically every week; for Christians its ceremonial observance replaces that of the Sabbath. In Christ's Passover, Sunday fulfills the spiritual truth of the Jewish Sabbath and announces man's eternal rest in God. For worship under the Law prepared for the mystery of Christ, and what was done there prefigured some aspects of Christ.

The Sunday Obligation The precept of the Church specifies the law of the Lord more precisely: "On Sundays and other holy days of obligation the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass / Divine Liturgy." "The precept of participating in the Mass / Divine Liturgy is satisfied by assistance at a Mass / Divine Liturgy which is celebrated anywhere in a Catholic rite either on the holy day or on the evening of the preceding day." The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation, unless excused for a serious reason (for example,

illness, the care of infants) or dispensed by their own pastor. **Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin.**
