**WEEK OF THE MYRRH-BEARING WOMEN** - This week we honor those women who served Jesus throughout His ministry and who were faithful to Him even to the Cross. After His burial, they came with love to anoint His most pure body and instead became the first witnesses of His resurrection. As we honor them is week with our own acts of service to others, we also proclaim our faith in the resurrection and rejoice in Christ's gift of life.

From the Pentecostarion: Why do you sprinkle your myrrh with tears, O women disciples? The stone is rolled away, and the tomb is empty; behold, Life has triumphed over Death. The seals give brilliant witness: that the guards of the godless have watched in vain, that mortal nature has been saved by the flesh of God, and that Hades is in mourning. Hasten in joy, proclaiming to the apostles, that Christ, the conqueror of Death, is the first-born of the dead. He shall go before you into Galilee.

The women prepared myrrh to anoint You and secretly came to Your tomb early in the mornings. They feared the boldness of the Jews, and they expected the soldiers to be keeping guard. But their weakness triumphed over manly strength for tenderness finds favor with God. And so they cry out: Arise, O Lord, protect us and save us for the love of Your Name.

Before the sun was up, a group of women sought the true Sun, whom they believed had set in the tomb. To theses myrrh-bearers, the radiant angel appeared and said: 'The resplendent Light enlightens those who sleep in the darkness. Go and announce to the radiant disciples that sorrow is now changed into joy. With a confident heart and clapping of hands, cry out with joy: The Pasch of joy saves us. Christ is risen and grants mercy to the world.
