

Fast is a strict abstinence from Wednesday, 1 August until Tuesday, 14 August, with the usual mitigations (wine and oil) for Saturday and Sunday and the Feast of the Transfiguration (6 August). It is therefore observed as is the Great Fast. The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a penitential season [Canon 880, §2] (and a time to avail oneself of the Mystery of Repentance). The observance of this fast is voluntary.

August 1st: Because of the many diseases that occur in the month of August, the custom prevailed of old in Constantinople to carry the precious Wood of the Cross in procession throughout the city for its sanctification and its deliverance from illnesses. It was brought forth from the imperial treasury

on the last day of July and placed upon the Holy Table of the Great Church of the Holy Wisdom; and beginning August 1 until the Dormition of the Theotokos, it was carried in procession throughout the city and was set forth for veneration before the people.



**Wisdom from the Holy Fathers:** «This life is neither a joke nor a plaything, although men may turn it into either. □ Remember to bring <u>FLOWERS</u> and <u>HERBS</u> to church to be blessed on Tuesday evening, 14 August, and Wednesday morning, 15 August, as part of our Dormition celebration. Some things to do to honor this most holy Feast of the Dormition: Use the Troparion and Kontakion hymns as prayers before and / or after meals, and as part of your and your children's evening prayers during the 8-day "after feast", until 23 August. If you have an icon of this feast, display it in your family's place of prayer for veneration. Use the front cover of our parish bulletin if you do not have one. If there are children at home, discuss the icon with them so that they are able to recognize all the figures and be able to tell the story. (Adults should also be able to tell the story!) Use the flowers blessed at the end of the Divine Liturgy to decorate the icon or the family table. Make an extra bouquet for someone who cannot come to Church.

**REMINDER**: Criteria for being a member of the Catholic Church **in good standing**. A sponsor...
