DORMITION FAST: The traditional rule for the Dormition Fast is a strict abstinence from Wednesday, 1 August until Tuesday, 14 August, with the usual mitigations (wine and oil) for Saturday and Sunday and the Feast of the Transfiguration (6 August). It is therefore observed as is the Great Fast. The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a penitential season [Canon 880, §2] (and a time to avail oneself of the Mystery of Repentance) The observance of this fast is voluntary.

We welcome into the Life of the Trinity the daughter of Thomas and Kyla Shultz, Jr. of Jefferson Hills, PA, and granddaughter of Thomas and Nancy Shultz Sr. at this Sunday morning's Divine Liturgy. Margaret MaKenna Shultz will receive the Three Mysteries of Christian Initiation: Holy Baptism, Holy Chrismation, and the Divine Eucharist. Let us remember in our prayers this newest member of the Body of Christ and all the infants and children in our parish who have been clothed in Christ and are becoming partakers of the Divine Nature.
