~ The Peter and Paul (Apostles) Fast ~

The Apostles Fast began, 3 June, after Vespers and lasts until June 28. The Typikon prescribes strict abstinence on **Mondays**, **Wednesdays**, and **Fridays**, with a mitigated abstinence (Wine and Oil) on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a penitential season (Canon 880, §2). This fast may be observed voluntarily.

Being one of the **four fasting periods** of the Church, this is also a proper and salutary time for receiving our Lord's loving forgiveness in the Mystery of Holy Confession.



The star of stars and the Forerunner, John, the one desired by God, **today** is born on earth from a barren womb, and he reveals the star of Christ, the Orient from on high and the Passover of all the faithful.

Today the great Precursor appears, born from the barren womb of Elizabeth. He is a prophet greater that all prophets; there is no other like him, nor has there ever been. For the most wondrous Light followed the lamp of the Forerunner;



the Word followed the voice, and the Bridegroom followed the bridegroom's friend. He prepares a special people for the Lord, cleansing them with water until the coming of the Spirit. He is the offspring of Zechariah and the noble dweller of the desert, the preacher of repentance, and the purification of sins. He announces the good news of the Resurrection from the dead to those in Hades, and he prays for our souls.

How wonderful is the miracle! The highest prophet of those born of women ends the condemnation of his mother's barrenness. He came forth with the Spirit and the power of Elijah to make straight the way of the Lord. How unspeakable is your compassion O Master. By it, O Christ, save our souls, for You alone are merciful.
