Saint John Chrysostom's thoughts on today's gospel pericope: «For as the sower makes no distinction in the land submitted to him, but simply and indifferently casts his seed; so the Lord Himself makes no distinction between rich and poor, between wise and unwise, between slothful and diligent, between brave and cowardly, but He discourses unto all.»

«...It is impossible for rock to become earth, or the wayside not to be wayside, or the thorns, thorns, but, in reason-endowed creatures [mankind], this is not so. In them, it is possible for the rock to change and become rich land, and for the wayside no longer to be trampled upon, nor lie open to all that pass by, but that it may be a fertile field; and the thorns may be destroyed, so that the seed may enjoy full security. For had it been impossible, this Sower [Christ] would not have sown.»
