- **2018 ASSEMBLY:** Metropolitan William will convene an Archeparchial Assembly on **September 16 – 18**. It will take place at our Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in Munhall. The title of the 2018 Assembly is *Concern for our Future* with the theme: *Renew, Revitalize, and Rejuvenate – Our Church in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century*. Each parish in the Archeparchy is asked to send two representatives. The days will be comprised of presentations and small group discussions focusing on six topics: (1) Diversity, (2) Technology and Social Media, (3) Mixed Marriages, (4) Education, (5) Social Activities, (6) Outreach to members who have left the church. At the 2018 Assembly opportunities will be provided for the participants to share information with one another regarding the best practices that have impacted growth and vitality in their parish.
