GUIDELINES FOR OPENING THE CHURCH FOR THE FEAST OF PENTECOST:

- Wear something **GREEN**.
- Anyone, especially those who are 60+ in age, who is not in good health, has underlying medical issues, or is fearful and anxious about being infected with the Coronavirus are urged to remain at home. The Sunday obligation to attend the Divine Liturgy is suspended as before. I encourage you to continue watching live streamed services or listen on the radio.
- Social Distancing will be observed. Families living together may sit together.
- **MASKS** are to be worn when you enter the church.
- Individual hand sanitizer packets will be located in the Narthex as you enter. You will also find small zip-lock plastic bags. Please do not leave it in your pew, but dispose of it at home.
- OFFERTORY ENVELOPES will be deposited in the wooden box at the entrance to the nave. No **ushers** until further notice.
- The APOSTOLIC READING will be done by one of the cantors. No lectors until further notice.
- Because ours is a sung liturgy, and droplets travel even farther when singing, the **Cantors** will sing from the upper balcony.
- **Acolytes** will not serve in the altar until further notice.
- THE CHURCH MUST BE SANITIZED AFTER EACH LITURGY.
- Lastly, the above can be adjusted as changes in the pandemic permit.

DISTRIBUTIUON OF THE DIVINE EUCHARIST

- Communicants will remain in their pew and approach the Chalice one pew at a time.
- Wooden spoons will be used to give communion. A new spoon will be used for the next person coming to receive. This will allow even the very young to continue receiving the Sacrament. If you feel uncomfortable about this method, choosing not to receive, still come forward for a blessing from Christ Who is truly present in the Chalice.
