



Ambon Prayer for Sunday of All Saints

The Apostles Fast begins Sunday evening, 7 June, after Vespers and lasts until June 28. The Typikon prescribes strict abstinence on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, with a mitigated abstinence (Wine and Oil) on Tuesday and Thursday. The Ruthenian Metropolia has identified this period as a penitential season (Canon 880, 2). Being one of the four fasting periods of the Church, this is also a proper and salutary time for receiving our Lord's loving forgiveness in the Mystery of Holy Confession.

- The annual **PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION** will be taken the weekend of **June 13th – 14th**. In ninth-century England, King Alfred the Great collected money, a "pence," from landowners as financial support for the pope. Today, the Peter's Pence Collection supports the pope's philanthropy by giving the holy father the means to provide emergency assistance to those in need because of natural disaster, war, oppression, and disease.
- **FATHER'S DAY** is **Sunday, June 21st**. Spiritual Bouquet cards are available in the Narthex.
- **PARISH HALL ROOF:** The time has finally come when we can no longer continue to «band-aid» the multiple leaks that have had to be plugged for over a decade now. The Building and Maintenance Committee has been actively contacting various contractors for bids on the cost to replace the flat roof portion only. Three proposals/bids were sent to the Archbishop for final approval since any repair work over \$7500 must have his authorization. Of the three estimates that came in, the Building and Maintenance Committee recommended we accept that of Burns – Scalo Inc. of Pittsburgh, which the Archbishop approved. Work on the flat roof is expected to start mid to late June at a cost of ca. \$70,000. **If you would like to give a donation for this project, in order to help offset the cost, please use one of the 'special' envelopes and write «hall roof» on the front.**
- On **Sunday, July 12, 2020** at the Cathedral of St John in Munhall, Metropolitan William will ordain seminarians Robert Jones and **Kyprian Wojciechowski [grandson of Michael Skapura, Sr.]** to the Order of Sub-diaconate. He will then also ordain Sub-deacon Robert Jones to the Diaconate. Kindly keep them in prayer. And know that in some small way our parish, through your support of our seminary throughout the year, has helped to make this day possible for these men.
