

**ABBEY OF THE DORMITION** is a Benedictine abbey in Jerusalem on Mt. Zion just outside the walls of the Old City near the Zion Gate. The present church is built upon an older Byzantine Church, which in turn was built over the actual house where Mary fell asleep, died.



The Dormition figure above is in the center of the crypt and is the work of Brother Radbod Commandeur OSB (Maria Laach Abbey, Germany). Every day hundreds of pilgrims kneel around the lying statue of the Virgin, who looks at her son as she dies: from the dome mosaic above her, He is waiting for her with his arms wide open to take her body and soul to heaven. He is surrounded by six women from the Old Covenant, who each went their very own way with God: Eve and Miriam, Ruth and Esther, Jael and Judith. Originally the robe of the statue of Mary was made of silver and gilded. After the 1948 war and the occupation of the church, only the wooden core remained. The ivory hands also had to be replaced and the nose in the ivory face also repaired.

CHURCH OF THE SEPULCHER OF SAINT MARY, also known as the TOMB OF THE VIRGIN MARY is located in the Kidron Valley – at the foot of Mount of Olives, in Jerusalem – believed by Eastern Christians to be the burial place of the Theotokos.



To the right of the altar is the entrance into the tomb.
