

Come, O Faithful, let us celebrate the feast of the Fiftieth Day: the day which concludes the Feast of Feasts; the day on which the pre-ordained promise is fulfilled; the day when the Comforter descend upon the earth in tongues of fire; the day of the disciples' enlightenment. They are revealed as initiated into the heavenly mysteries, for truly the light of the Comforter has illumined the world.


Come, all you nations of the world, let us adore God in three holy persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – three in one. From all eternity, The Father begets the Son, equal to Him in eternity and majesty, equal also to the Holy Spirit, glorified with the Son in the Father, three persons, and yet a single power and essence and Godhead. In deep adoration, let us cry out to God: **Holy is God** who made all things through the Son with the cooperation of the Holy Spirit. **Holy the Mighty One** through Whom the Father was revealed to us, and through Whom the Holy Spirit came to this world. **Holy the Immortal One**, the Spirit and Comforter Who proceeds from the Father and reposes in the Son. All-holy Trinity, glory be to You!

We Your faithful people, O Lord, prostrate our souls and bodies before You. We sing a hymn of praise to You, the eternal Father; and to Your Son, equal to You in eternity; and to Your all-holy Spirit, coeternal with You, the Enlightenment and Sanctifier of our souls.

Enveloped by the divine cloud, the man of unsure speech [Moses] taught the Law written by God; wiping the dust from his eyes, he saw the One-Who-is, and he was initiated into the knowledge of the Spirit. Let us praise him with inspired songs.

The Seventy Elders: So the LORD said to Moses, *«Gather for Me seventy of the elders of Israel, whom you know to be the elders of the people and officers over them; bring them to the Tent of Meeting, and have them take their place there with you. I will come down and talk with you there; and I will take some of the Spirit that is on you and put it on them; and they shall bear the burden of the people along with you so that you will not bear it all by yourself.»* [...] So Moses went out and told the people the words of the LORD; and he gathered seventy elders of the people, and placed them all around the tent. Then the LORD came down in the cloud and spoke to him, and took some of the Spirit that was on him and put it on the seventy elders; and when the Spirit rested upon them, they prophesied. But they did not do so again. Two men remained in the camp, one named Eldad, and the other named Medad, and the spirit rested on them; they were among those registered, but they had not gone out to the tent, and so they prophesied in the camp. And a young man ran and told Moses, *«Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp.»* And Joshua son of Nun, the assistant of Moses, one of his chosen men, said, *«My lord Moses, stop them!»* But Moses said to him, *«Are you jealous for my sake? Would that all the LORD's people were prophets, and that the LORD would put His Spirit on them!»*
