HEBREW FOR CHRISTIANS: The word **HOSANNA** consists of two parts. The first part, **hoshi'a-**, comes from the verb meaning *to be saved* or *delivered*. The suffix **-na** expresses *intense emotion* and is often translated as «please». **Hōshi'a + ná**, therefore, may be translated along the lines of: «Save now», «Save please!» or «Save

I / we pray!» All four gospels record our Lord's entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, but Luke never uses the word «Hosanna». By the time of Christ's triumphant entree, «Hosanna» had curiously evolved from an expression of deep anguish or cry for help to a kind of cheer, a cry of happiness. *Hosanna* occurs six times in the New Testament. In our Divine Liturgy, we sing this Hebrew word in the «**Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of Hosts...**», the hymn sung by the seraphim in Isaiah's vision of God revealed to the prophet while in the Temple in Jerusalem.
