

LITURGICAL CHANGES: Because of the penitential nature of the Nativity / Philip Fast, the Typical Psalms and the Beatitudes will be sung in place of the Resurrection Antiphons at the Divine Liturgy. The **Typical Psalms** will be sung using Setting A, pp. 16 – 17 and the **Beatitudes** to Kontakion Tone 8 pp. 23 – 24 in the Divine Liturgies pew book. This will be posted on the

hymn boards in the front of the Nave. Special hymns for the fast will be placed in the individual pews and the faithful are encouraged to sing them along with the cantor(s) during the Great Incensation at the start of the Divine Liturgy. The **EMMANUEL MOLEBEN** will be served at 18:30 on all Wednesdays during the Fast.

THANKSGIVING DAY TROPARION: You made the earth, O God, and all it contains. You have given us a share in Your life. All creation sings praise to You. FYODOR MICHAILOVICH DOSTOEVSKY'S 200th birthday was this past November 11th (October 30th Old Style) and is considered by many as one of the leading literary authors of western civilization in the 19th century. He was a devout Orthodox Christian when many among Russia's intelligentsia were not. A 21st century member of a St. Petersburg book club wrote: «After I finished the Karamazov brothers, I had this impression that, if everyone would read this book, we would probably be living in a better place. The questions that are raised in this book are timeless; they are current and relevant. The *Brothers Karamazov* was one of the most impressive books I have read in my whole life.»
