



THE HOLY APOSTLE JUDE, one of the twelve apostles of Christ, is descended from Kings David and Solomon, and was the son of Righteous Joseph the Betrothed by his first wife. He also had other names: the Evangelist Matthew calls him "**Lebbæus**, whose surname

was **Thaddeus**". Mark also calls him **Thaddeus**, and in the Acts of the Holy Apostles he is called **Barsabas**. After the Ascension of the Lord, Jude traveled about preaching the Gospel. He spread the faith in Christ at first in Judea, Galilee, Samaria and Idumaia, and later in the lands of Arabia, Syria and Mesopotamia. Finally, he went to the city of Edessa. Here he finished the work that was not completed by his predecessor, Saint Thaddeus, Apostle of the Seventy.



AMBON PRAYER: NATIVITY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST: O Forerunner, Prophet, and Baptist, while still in your mother's womb you recognized the Master and leapt in worship. You were born from a womb that had been barren and from infancy yearned for the height of virtue and to live in the pathless desert. You became the herald of repentance, the baptizer of our Lord, and, by grace, a witness of the Holy Trinity. Rightly did the Lord call you greater than anyone born of woman. O Christ our God, You were baptized by him and enlightened the whole world, send us now Your heavenly assistance and have mercy on all of us. For to You is due all glory, together with Your eternal Father and Your all-holy, good and life-creating Spirit, now and ever and unto the ages of ages. Amen.

LET US PREPARE TWO TABLES: When we return home, let us prepare two tables, one for bodily food, the other for that spiritual

food which is the Holy Scripture. Let the husband repeat what has been said in the holy assembly; let the wife learn it and the children listen to it. Let each of you make your home a Church. Are you not responsible for the salvation of your children? Are you not likely to have to give an account for their upbringing? Just as we the shepherds of the flock will give an account of what we have done for your souls, so fathers of families will have to answer before God for all the people in their home.
