THE BEHEADING OF JOHN THE BAPTIST is always celebrated on August 29th at the close of

our Church's ecclesiastical year. His conception is observed at the start of the new church year on September 23rd. Red vestments are worn on this day. By tradition a strict fast is observed. Local traditions also include such practices as not using knives, not eating food from a plate, or anything in the form of a head, *e.g.*, cabbage, lettuce, apples, *et cetera*.

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 1st **«HAPPY NEW YEAR 7531!»** In the eastern Roman Empire, in the Greek or Constantinopolitan Indictions, the first day (of the new year) of the indiction year was established initially as September 23, the birthday of the Emperor Augustus. This date also became the start of the Eastern Orthodox Church year. But late in the 5th



century, the start of the new year shifted to September 1, the present day beginning of our Church's liturgical year. In the west, in the Imperial or Western Indictions, September 24 was adopted as the start of the year, apparently based upon calculations of the Venerable Bede. In the 9th century, Roman or Pontifical Indictions were introduced in the west that began the year on either December 25 or January 1.
