DEMON POSSESSION SHOWS THE CRUELTY OF DEMONS. ST. CYRIL OF ALEXANDRIA: In great misery and nakedness, he wandered among the graves of the dead. He was in utter wretchedness, leading a disgraceful life. He was proof of the cruelty of the demons and a plain demonstration of their impurity.... Whoever they possess and subject to their power, at once they make him an example of great misery, deprived of every blessing, destitute of all sobriety, and entirely deprived even of reason.

Saint Cyril of Alexandria also writes, «The God of all purposely permits some to fall into [the power of evil spirits] yet, it will never happen that those who love Christ will become subject to them. It will never happen to us as long as we walk in his footsteps, avoid negligence in the performance of what is right, desire those things which are honorable, and belong to that virtuous and praiseworthy lifestyle that Christ has marked out for us by the precepts of the gospel.
