TROPARIA AND KONTAKIA FOR THE DAYS OF THE WEEK

Each day of the week is dedicated to a mystery of the Faith or to the Saints. Sunday, of course, is dedicated to our Lord's Resurrection and to the Most Holy Trinity, Monday to the Holy Angels. The traditional Monday prayers are: Troparion: O Captains and Leaders of the Armies of Heaven, unworthy as we are, we beseech you without ceasing to surround us with your intercessions and cover us beneath the shelter of the glory of your ethereal wings. We bend our knee and cry out with perseverance: Deliver us from danger, O Princes of the Powers on High! **Theotokion:** To the one who was reared in the Temple, close to the Holy of Holies, and who was full of faith, wisdom, and perfect virginity, Gabriel, the Captain and Leader, offered respect and greetings from Heaven saying: «Rejoice, O Blessed One! Rejoice, O Exalted One! The Lord is with you.» Kontakion: O Princes of the Leaders of God's Armies, servants of Divine Glory, instructors of men, and commanders of Angels: ask whatever is good for us, and bountiful mercy, O Princes of the Leaders of the Angels.

Lay Your Hands on Her WHOSE HANDS? PETER CHRYSOLOGUS: Those who are sick do not lay down the conditions of how they are to be cured. They only want to be made well. But this man was a ruler of the synagogue, and versed in the law. He had surely read that while God created all other things by His word, man had been created by the hand of God. He trusted therefore in God that his daughter would be recreated, and restored to life by that same hand which, he knew, had created her.... He who laid hands on her to form her from nothingness, once more lays hands upon her to reform her from what had perished. SERMON 33.3

THE GIRL AROSE. CHROMATIUS: In the synagogue ruler we perceive a figure of the prophets or apostles, especially Peter, by whom the calling of the Gentiles was first heard; that is, the girl represented all those holy people who pleased God, not through the works of the law but through the righteousness of faith.... Moreover, for us to understand that the entire mystery of our salvation is prefigured in this girl; after she was raised from the dead, as Luke reports, the Lord directs her to eat something. Evidently the order of our faith and salvation is here shown. For when each believer among us is freed in baptism from perpetual death and comes back to life upon acceptance of the gift of the Holy Spirit, it is necessary that the person also be directed to eat that heavenly bread about which the Lord says, "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you."
