

THE HOLY PROPHET OBADIAH whose name in Hebrew means – Servant of God – and whom the Church commemorates this day is counted among the twelve minor prophets of Israel. The book that bears his name is the shortest book in the Old Testament: only one chapter and containing only 291 Hebrew words. The book's main topic is the destruction of Jerusalem in 586 BC by the Babylonians and the putative actions of Edom against Judah at the time. The Edomites were considered to be kin to the Israelites since they were thought to have descended from Esau, the brother of our holy patriarch Jacob.

LITURGICAL CHANGES FOR THE NATIVITY FAST. In *lieu* of the Sunday Resurrection Antiphons, we will sing the **Typical Psalms** and the **Beatitudes**. During the Great Incensation at the start of the Divine Liturgy, the cantors will sing the two Philip Fast Hymns, copies of which are located in the pews. Please join them in singing these hymns.

THANKSIGIVING DAY TROPARION: You made the earth, O God, and all it contains. You have given us a share in Your life. All creation sings praise to You. As our forefathers gave You thanks after coming to these shores, we Your unworthy servants, also give thanks on this day for all Your benefits bestowed throughout the years.

THANKSIGIVING DAY KONTAKION: Today, O faithful, sing to God your thanksgiving hymns; learning Scripture's command to give thanks with heart as well as lips, and to seal lips and hearts with blessed deeds. Let America play her thankful part among the nations, giving praise to our saving Lord, the Benefactor of our souls.
