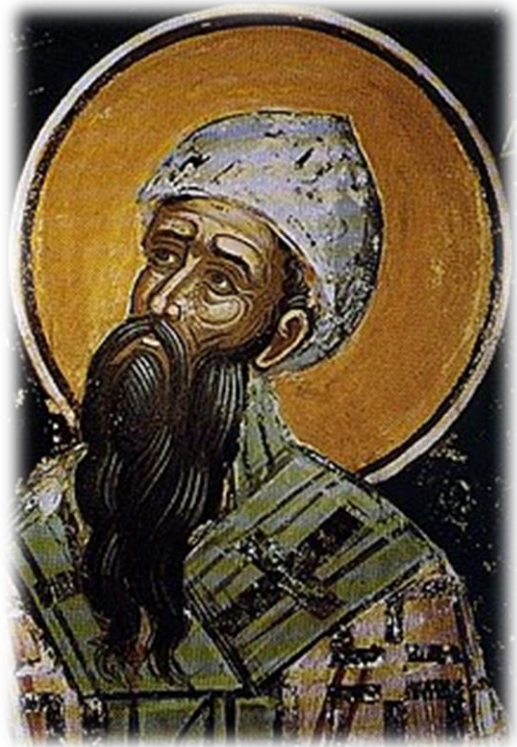
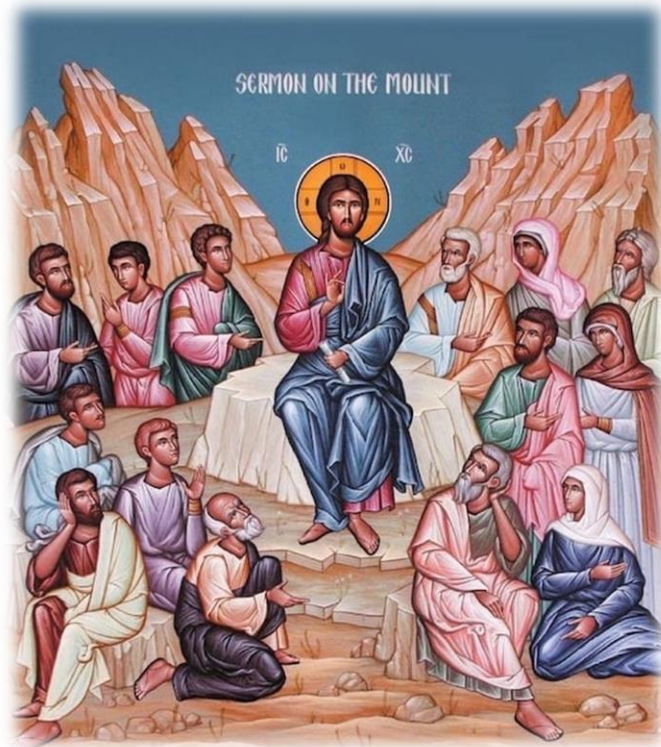

A MESSAGE OF CARE – When Jesus spoke, ears began to tingle! On a hillside in Galilee, Jesus gave His famous «Sermon on the Mount», of which this Sunday's Gospel is part. The world still marvels at it, for it was an astounding speech, introducing a radically different outlook on life and turning earthly values completely upside down. His words, however, jolted the world into hope.




Jesus taught that we should put our confidence in God rather than in material possessions. Jesus said not to worry excessively about the future, for the Lord Who takes care of the birds of the air and the lilies of the field will surely not neglect His children. Our heavenly Father knows what we need.
