SHE TOUCHED THE TASSELS OF HIS GARMENT: «The LORD said to Moses, "Speak to the people of Israel, and bid them to make **TASSELS** on the corners of their garments throughout their generations, and to put upon the **TASSEL** of each corner a cord of blue; and it shall be to you a **TASSEL** to look upon and remember all the commandments of the LORD, to do them, not to follow after your own heart and your own eyes, which you are inclined to go after wantonly. So you shall remember and do all my commandments, and be holy to your God.» (Numbers 15:38-40)

God commands Israel to put fringes on the corner of their clothes so that they will remember to do the commands of Torah. As the Hebrew mind focuses on

the concrete, God uses physical things as reminders and associations for non-physical things. In this case the fringes are reminders of the commands. The Hebrew word for *tassel* is derived from the word for a **BLOSSOM**. A blossom is a flower that grows on a tree and is the beginning of the **FRUIT**. Just as the blossom turns into a fruit, the fringes are also there as a reminder to bring about the good fruit that comes from doing what God expects. And Who is the perfection of doing God's commandments if not Jesus.
