**AMBON PRAYER FOR BRIGHT MONDAY:** «Passover, Passover», and again I say, «Passover», for Christ our Passover, has been sacrificed for us. He alone is immortal; He alone cannot be seen or grasped. The Angels and Principalities, the Authorities, Dominions and Powers, and the Cherubim and Seraphim praise Him. With these heavenly powers, we, Your unworthy servants, praise, bless, and worship You, O Lord our God, for in these last day You came into the world, took flesh from our holy and pure Lady, the Mother of God and ever-virgin Mary, and suffered crucifixion that You might free us from the curse of the tree. Bright Week: The first six days after Pascha constitute what is known in the Slave tradition as

*Bright Week* [*Renewal Week* in the Greek Church]. All the doors of the Iconostasis remain open during these six days, even when the services are concluded. The open doors remind us of the stone rolled away from the empty tomb of Christ. It also allows us to see the *Plashchenitsa* (symbol of the burial cloths left in the tomb) on the Holy Table. Funeral services held during Bright Week have a special rite, consisting entirely of joyous Paschal hymns from Resurrection Matins, only the litanies are funereal.
