

AMBON PRAYER FOR SUNDAY OF THE SAMARITAN WOMAN

Lord Jesus Christ our God, [...] You revealed the mystery of baptism to Your holy apostles, sending them out to reap the harvest of faith. In this way You fulfilled the promise made to the Samaritan woman that *«the water You shall give will become a spring of water welling up to eternal life.»* You have revealed to us the mystery of worship in Spirit and truth, coming to us more closely than to the people of Sychar, through Your precious gifts of Your holy Body and pure Blood. Having tasted Your goodness, may we always hear Your words and proclaim them to all who are thirsty for the living water of faith. For all glory is due to You, and to Your eternal Father, and to Your all-holy, good, and life-creating Spirit, now and ever and unto the ages of ages. Amen.

nce at the sixth hour [noon], O Master, our first mother Eve saw You walking in Paradise. Now her daughter, at the same hour, sees You, O Fountain of Life, sitting at the well, asking her for water to drink. You are the Fountain of living water. Her thirst was quenched by drinking of Your life-bearing streams. She proclaimed to those in the town: Come! Drink from the river of abundance.

t the sixth hour, You came to the well, O Fountain of Wonders, to ensnare the fruit of Eve; for at that same hour, she [Eve] had been driven from Paradise by the guile of the serpent. When the Samaritan woman came to draw water, You said to her, O Savior: *Give Me water to drink, and I will give you waters of eternal life*. And the woman hastened to the city and proclaimed to the people: *Come and see Christ the Lord, the Savior of our souls!*

SAMARIA is the region to the north of Jerusalem, between Judea and Galilee. Wells were

significant because of their rarity and their value in desert life. They, therefore, came to symbolize life itself (Ps 35:9, 10; 45:4; Is. 55:1). This particular well is maintained as a shrine to this day, and pilgrims can drink from it. The Samaritan woman became an early evangelist, testifying to the advent of Christ and bringing others to Him. According to an early tradition, after the Resurrection she was baptized with the name Photini, «the enlightened one,» Along with her two sons and five daughters, she went to the city of Carthage (in modern day Libya) to spread the gospel. She was later martyred with her family during the reign of the emperor Nero by being thrown into a well. Egual to the Apostles, St. Photini, (Svetlana in Russian; *Claire* in the West) is also remembered on 26 February in our liturgical calendar.
