

**SAINT CHARITON THE CONFESSOR** was born in the city of Iconium (south central Turkey) during the reign of the Roman Emperor Aurelian (*Lucius Domitius Aurelianus*), about *anno Domini* 274. He was arrested, tortured, and condemned to death because of his Christian Faith, but finally set free by imperial edict. He traveled to the Holy Land where he took up the ascetic life. He also brought many non-believers to the Faith. Having dwelt in the desert of Judea for many years, and having established several monasteries throughout the region, he reposed in peace.

THE PROPHET BARUCH was the son of Nerias, and a trusted friend of the Prophet Jeremiah (Jer. 32:9-15; 43:4 LXX). As a trusted friend he served as his secretary and reader in the Jerusalem Temple. The extant prophetical book that he wrote is divided into five chapters, composed in the fifth year of the Babylonian Captivity of the Jews during the years of King Zedekiah, ca. 581 B.C.. Baruch is the story of a Jewish community in exile that responds from the heart to the call to repentance. The prophetic passage that is read on the eve of the Feast of Christ's Nativity, which bears Jeremiah's name, is taken from the prophecy of Baruch (Bar. 3:35 - 4:4). His name means «blessed» in Hebrew.
