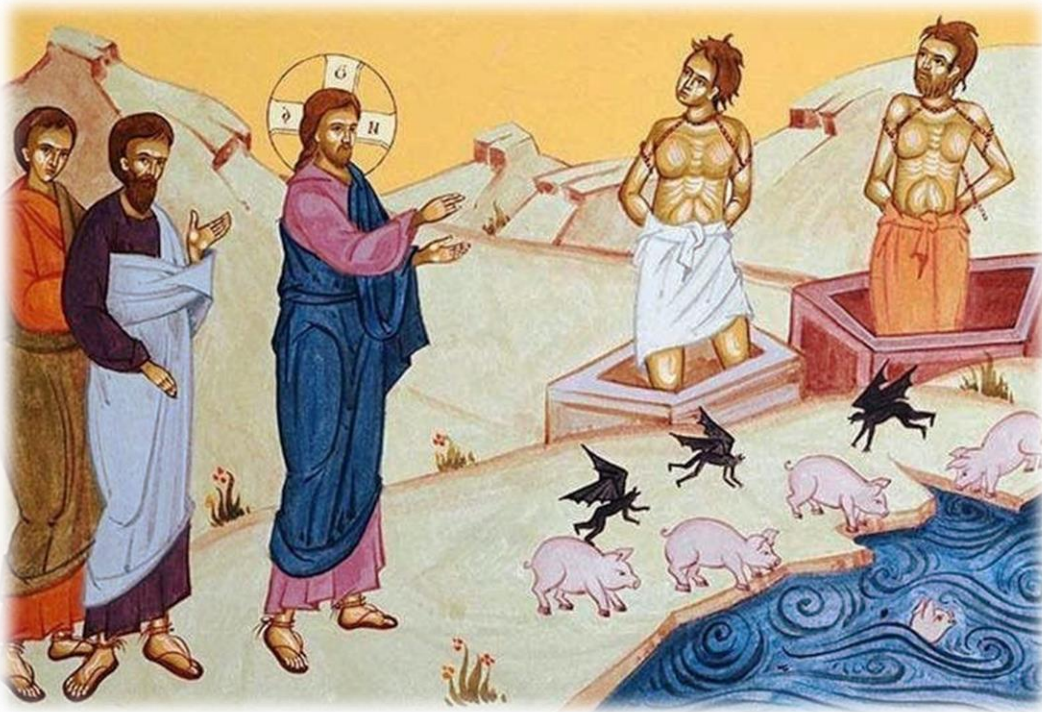

IF CHRIST LIVES IN US... Let no evil talk come out of your mouths, but only what is useful for building up as there is need, so that your words may give grace to those who hear. Resist him, steadfast in your faith, for you know that your brothers and sisters throughout the world are undergoing the same kinds of suffering. And after you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, Who has called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself restore, support, strengthen, and establish you. *1 Peter 5:5b-11*
