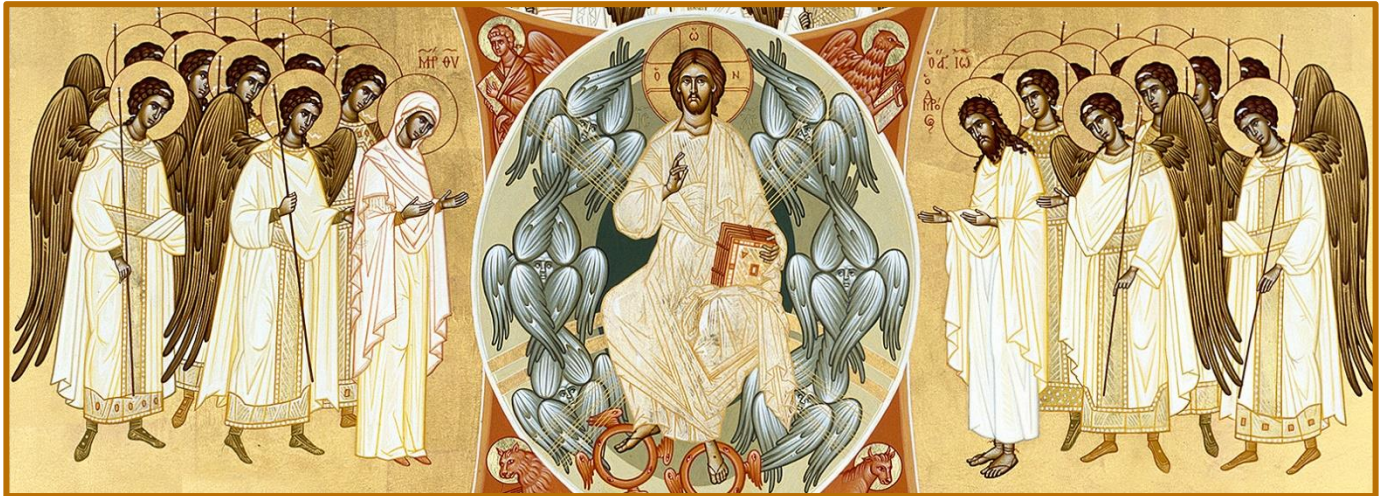

Ambon Prayer for the Sunday of All Saints

 Lord, glorious in the council of Your saints, You are the boast of the Apostles, the joy of prophets, the support of martyrs, the gladness of venerable ascetics, and the crown of the Theotokos. Give us Your peace and love. Guide and guard our lives, that through the mercy of Your goodness, we may be made worthy to imitate their struggles, and pleasing You, to attain

future happiness with them. For You bestow every eternal good gift, and we give glory to You, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, now and ever and unto the ages of ages. Amen.

The close connection between last Sunday's solemn feast of **Pentecost** and today's feast of **All Saints** is that sanctity, holiness is the **fruit of the Spirit**, which is **love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control**. (Gal. 5:22)

The veneration of saints is vital to the life of the Church because the existence of saints affirms that it is truly possible to fulfill the Christian vocation – to become conformed to the image of Christ. Every Christian is called to be a saint. Christ commanded us to be perfect (holy) as our heavenly Father is perfect (holy). The saints worked hard to achieve that spiritual perfection and are the Church's Olympic champions – gold medal winners. They cooperated with God in doing His will, and allowed the Holy Spirit to fill them and use them. They achieved this blessed condition through their great spiritual exercises: by prayer, fasting, abstinence, repentance, receiving the Holy Mysteries; by living lives of simplicity, humility, love, patience, purity, and obedience; by reading the Holy Scriptures, the Church Fathers and Mothers, the lives of saints, and most especially, by allowing God's love to overflow through them to all creation. The saints dedicated their lives to loving God above all else, serving Him according to the talents that they received. Their «job descriptions» varied, but they always served the world around them.

The Peter and Paul (Apostles) Fast begins this Sunday evening; it's final day is 28 June. The Feast of Saints Peter and Paul on June 29th is a holy day of obligation.
